"We make the product to meet whatever the need may be," Kenney said. "If you need a standard coupling, we have that. If you need a heavyduty coupling, we make two styles. We think we're pretty responsive to the needs of the market."

For example, special-molding machines take raw Neoprene, melt it, and use it to form the gaskets used in standard and HUSKY couplings. An aggressive quality-control program at Anaco requires that these gaskets meet the most rigorous requirements.

The same commitment to quality that goes into the molding of gaskets also is found in the production of the stainless steel bands and shields. Rolls of high-quality Series 300 stainless steel are converted into these bands and corrugated shields right in the Anaco production plants, where finished products are inspected and tested to ensure product integrity. Components and parts that don't meet the standards are discarded, with only the very best couplings passing through to the shipping department for transport to customers.

"I've been in this business a long time and I can honestly say that we make a better product than our competitor. I know I may be biased, but it's absolutely true," Kenny said.
